Community of Christ (CofC) Members Camp Moja – Lake Doniphan – June 9-14

We are excited you're applying to volunteer with Camp Moja this year!

It is very important that you read through this document thoroughly.

There are four steps required to become a new counselor:

- 1. complete the youth worker application and interview;
- 2. complete a phone interview with one of the directors;
- 3. complete the online Moja registration;
- **4.** attend training.

COMMUNITY OF CHRIST MEMBERS

If you are a CofC member, you will need to turn in the "children and youth worker confidential application" to your pastor, and then you'll need to complete the youth worker interview with your pastor.

- 5. which CofC mission center you completed your youth worker certification through and in what year.

YOUTH WORKER APPLICATION

You will need to print the application, fill out by hand and return it to your pastor before April 20.

Page 1-2 to be completed by applicant

Date of Application/Date of Birth: As requested, digits please.

Full Name/Address/Telephone: As requested.

Other: If you go by a nickname that is not your legal name.

Email: This will be a primary source of contact, so please put an address you check regularly. **Criminal Offenses/Investigations/Administrative Actions:** As requested; if the answer is "yes" to any of the questions, you should <u>contact legal services immediately</u> to discuss "special circumstances" or include additional information.

Congregational Affiliation: The applicant must fulfill the six-month rule; if not associated with a CofC congregation for six months or more, the person must comply with the following criteria for references:

- In addition to the two others, one of these following references must be provided:
 - pastor of the church the applicant attends;
 - CofC member who has known the applicant longer than 12 months;
 - a leader of the community where they live who knows them (e.g. high school principal, doctor, employer).

References: Three references are required (no relatives); full address and contact details must be included in this section, including their email and phone number; references must be at least 18 years of age, and you must include at least one person who is a pastor, boss, teacher or other professional.

Applicant's Signature: A parent's signature must be completed for anyone younger than 18 years of age at the time of application; **electronic signatures are not permitted.**

(*Pages 3-5 will be filled out by the camp staff/pastor after speaking to all three references and conducting the interview.*)
